Nijampur-Jaitane Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's Jagannath Kadwadas Shah Adarsh College is a renowned institution imparting higher education in hilly area of Dhulia District in Maharashtra. The mission of our college is "Empower the rural and tribal students through value based and life oriented quality education". Most of the admitted students come from hilly and tribal areas. They are first generation learners. Our institution maintains the standards in teaching and learning process. The College offers B.A. degree in special subjects English, Marathi, Hindi, Political Science, and Sociology. Geography, Economics, History, and Defence Studies are offered as general subjects. The college also offers certificate courses and Add-on courses. Institution runs three years undergraduate course since the inception. The college implements Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) pattern as per the guidelines and circular of Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. The syllabus of the academic year is completed within time by the teachers. Teaching plan is prepared at the beginning of every academic year. Time table committee is constituted by the Principal to bring transparency in teaching and learning in the college. The prepared time table and details about the courses offered by the college is displayed on the notice board, college website, college prospectus and social networking sites. The faculty completes the syllabus as per the teaching plan. Teaching diary is mandatorily to the whole faculty. Diary is being completed and maintained by the subject teachers in every year. Faculty updates their knowledge about syllabus by attending workshops and seminars conducted by other colleges and university. The Principal checks the diary regularly. Syllabus is completed successfully by the teachers in time. Curriculum Feedback is designed by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) department of the college and circulated to the stakeholders. Feedback forms collected from the stakeholders at end of the every academic year and the feedback get analyzed for highly satisfied response rate of curriculum. Feedback is taken to measure the completion of syllabus successfully. Performance Appraisal System is also one of the parameters which have been collected at the end of academic year. Extra classes are conducted by the teachers to complete the syllabus. The college has adequate ICT tools for students and teachers. These tools have been properly used by the teachers for effective curriculum delivery to the students in time. During COVID-19 Pandemic period, faculty makes use of Social Networking Sites (SNS) like WhatsApp group and Telegram for instruction to students regarding the syllabus and scheduled of teaching-learning. Teachers use varies online applications and techniques to complete the syllabus and course by conducting online class via Zoom and Google classrooms. Teachers record their topic wise video lectures and upload it on college YouTube channels. of the collage and share to students. Students attended classes via online mode during the COVID-19 pandemic. Syllabus completion reports it submitted to the Principal by the faculty. All measures of syllabus completion are taken into consideration in above mentioned points in details.
