## Title of the First Best Practice Personality Development of Yuwati

## 2. The Context

• The college is situated in hilly area. The girls come to college from hilly and tribal area. They do not get adequate facilities of education. They are not willing to complete education due to financial and social situation. They get married early and leave their higher education incomplete. These are the challenges for higher education of girls. The college organized one day national workshop on *Digital Literacy for* 

Women Empowerment on 28 December 2019. The college established 'Yuwati Sabha' to empower the girls. 'Yuwati Sabha' organizes various activities to empower the girls in every academic year. The planning of girls activities are systematically and effectively implemented throughout the academic year. To empower girls has become the mission of college. The college also aims to empowering rural, hilly and tribal women.
