## **Report on Feedback Collected and Analyzed on Curriculum Feedback Obtained From Various Stakeholders during 2017-18**

The feedback plays the crucial role in academic field. Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) decided to prepare the Feedback in IQAC Meeting unanimously. The feedback forms have been designed specially by the IQAC team members. The feedback form consists of particulars specific to the students and alumni for there are questions which are rated on a four point rating scale (Excellent-4, Good-3, Satisfactory-2 and Poor-1) and also teachers and parents for the feedback question which are rated on a four point rating scale (Strongly Agree -4, Agree -3, Neither Agree Nor Disagree -2 and Disagree -1). IQAC circulated the Feedback on Curriculum to all stakeholders randomly in manually computerized format. IQAC collects the feedback on curriculum from various stakeholders; students, teachers, alumni, employers and parents. The collected feedback is then analysed statistically and graphically. Curriculum is designed by the affiliating Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Stakeholders is mentioned their opinion and choose better option which is suitable. Remark of the stakeholders is to write in Action Taken Report of feedback on curriculum.

### **Analysis on Feedback of Curriculum**

The college consider the curriculum of under graduate programme is the important role in entire three year degree course. Curriculum is based on Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The CBCS pattern is implemented by the Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon and adopted by the affiliated colleges. Feedback of Curriculum is designed as per CBCS pattern. Collected feedback form is analysed timely by the IQAC department and submitted to the College Development Committee (CDC).

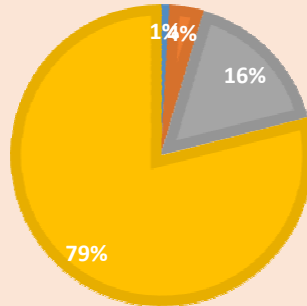

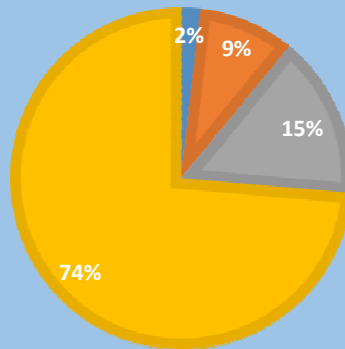

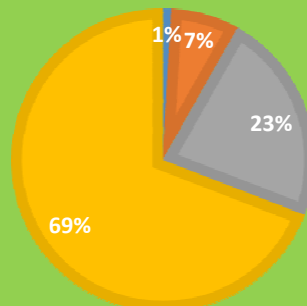
### SUITABILITY OF THE COURSE SEMESTER WISE

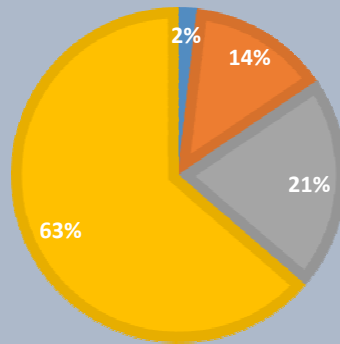
### PROVISION OF SUFFICIENT CHOICES FOR THE STUDENTS IN SELECTING COURSES

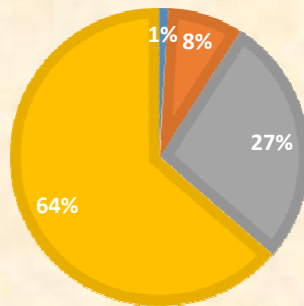
### AVAILABILITY OF INTERDISCIPLINARY COURSE

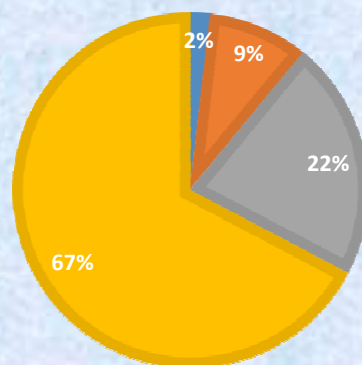
### OPPORTUNITY FOR DEVELOPING SKILLS IN THE CURRICULUM

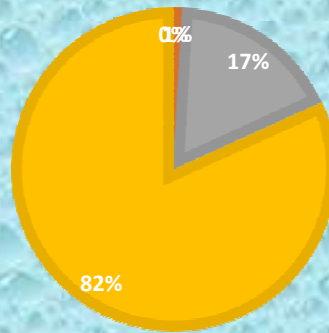
### DEPTH OF THE CURRICULUM

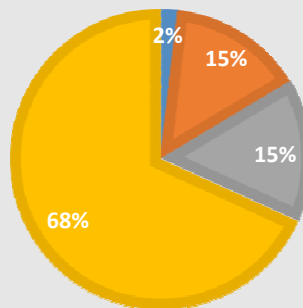

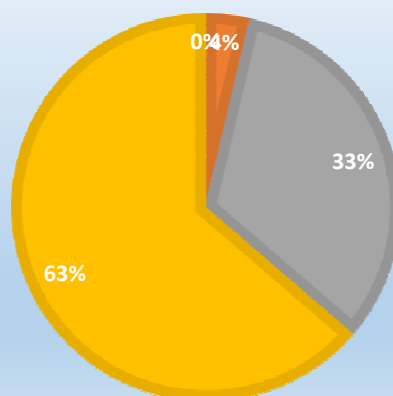
### RELEVANCE OF THE COURSE FOR PROVIDING EMPLOYABILITY

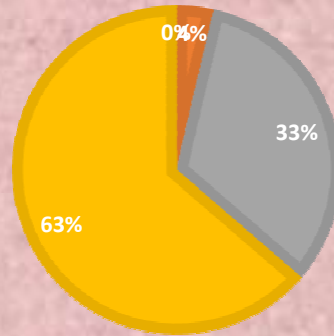

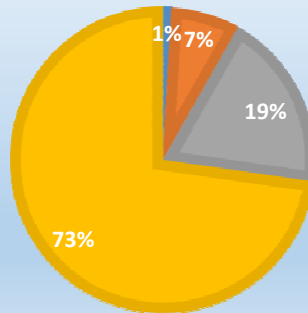

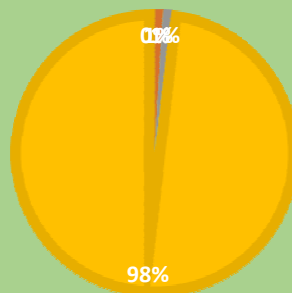
### KNOWLEDGE BASED CURRICULUM

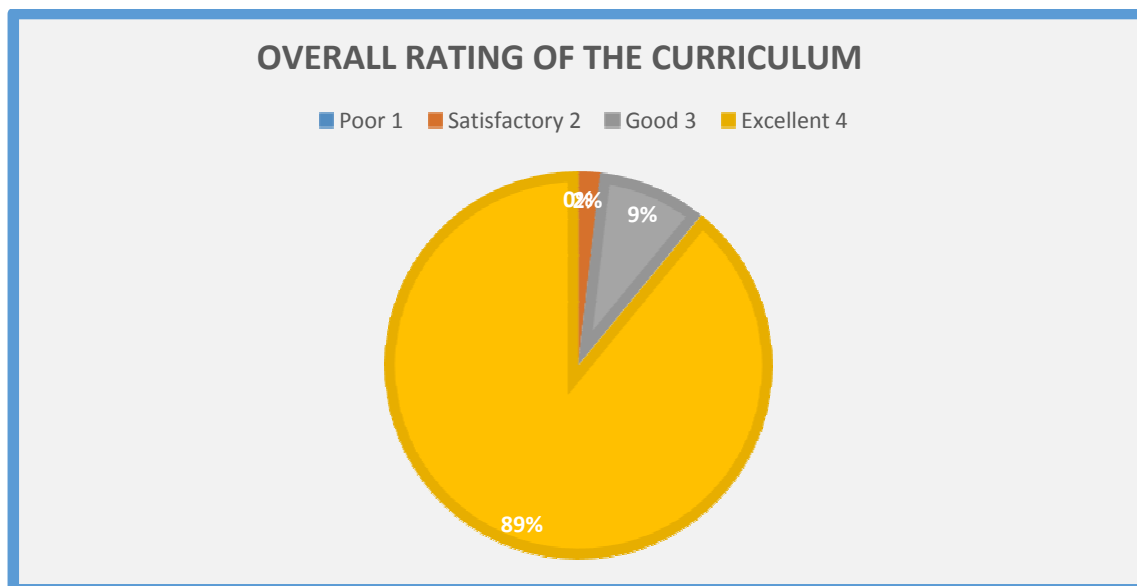


### DESIGNED CURRICULUM AS PER NORTH MAHARASHTRA UNIVERSITY, JALGAON

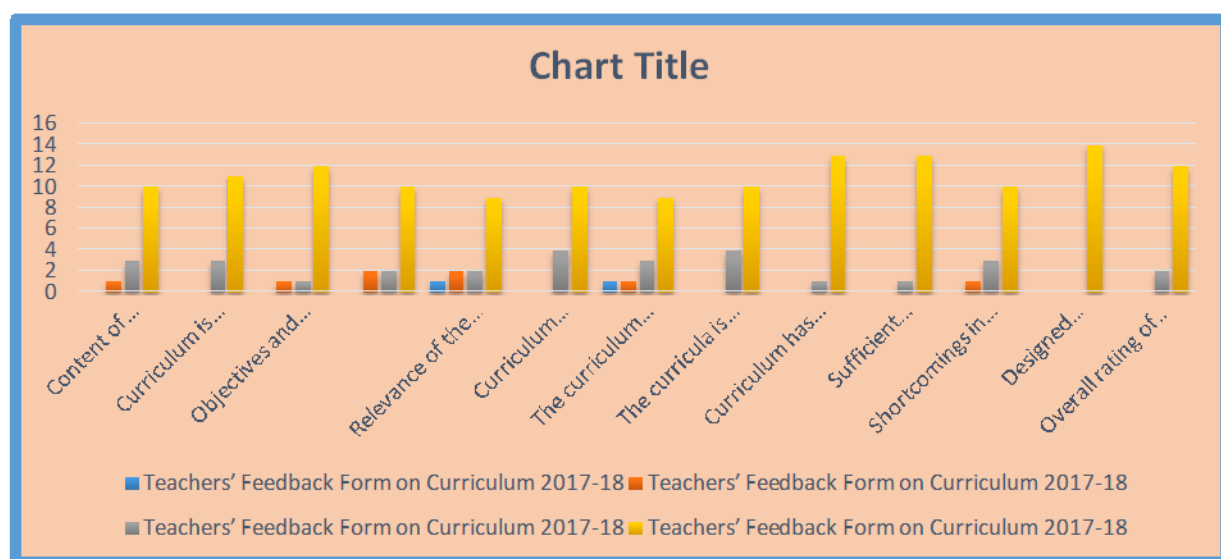

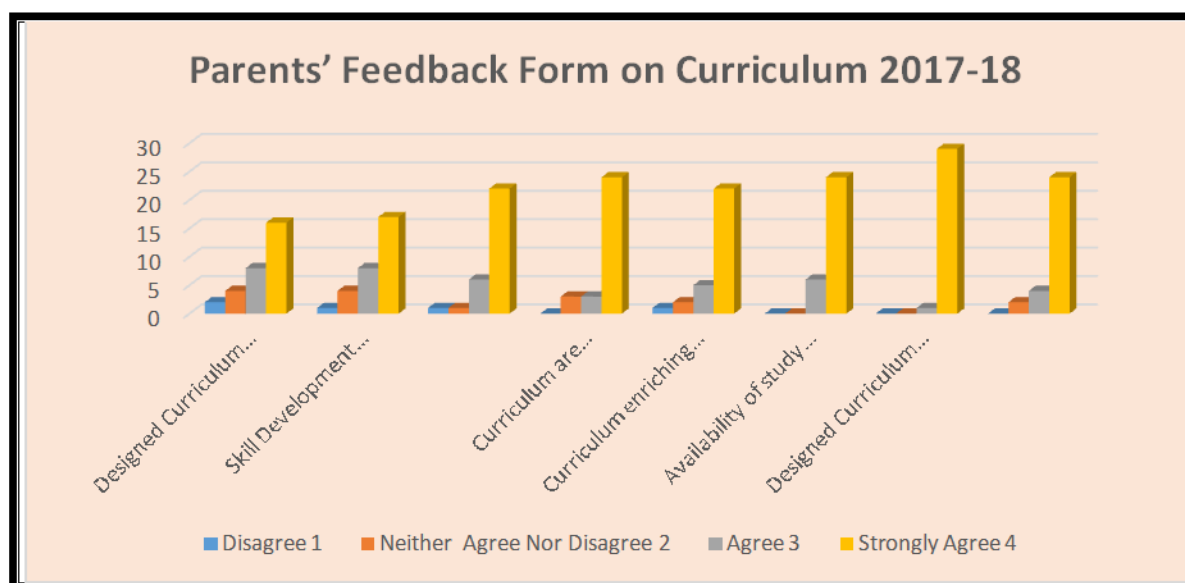
