## Report on Feedback Collected and Analyzed on Curriculum Feedback Obtained From Various Stakeholders during 2018-19

The feedback plays the crucial role in academic field . Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) decided to prepare the Feedback in IQAC Meeting unanimously. The feedback forms have been designed specially by the IQAC team members. #### **Analysis on Feedback of Curriculum**

The college consider the curriculum of under graduate pr ogramme is the important role in entire three year degree course. Curriculum is based on Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The CBCS pattern is implemented by the Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon and adopted by the affili ated colleges. CBCS pattern is started with effect from 2018 for FYBA and regular old pattern for SYBA and TYBA, Feedback of Curriculum is designed as per CBCS pattern. Collected feedback form is analysed timely by the IQAC department and submitted to the College Development Committee (CDC).

#### Students' Feedback on Curriculum 2018-19


































## Teacher' Feedback on Curriculum 2018-19
