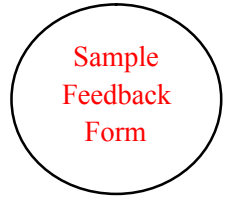

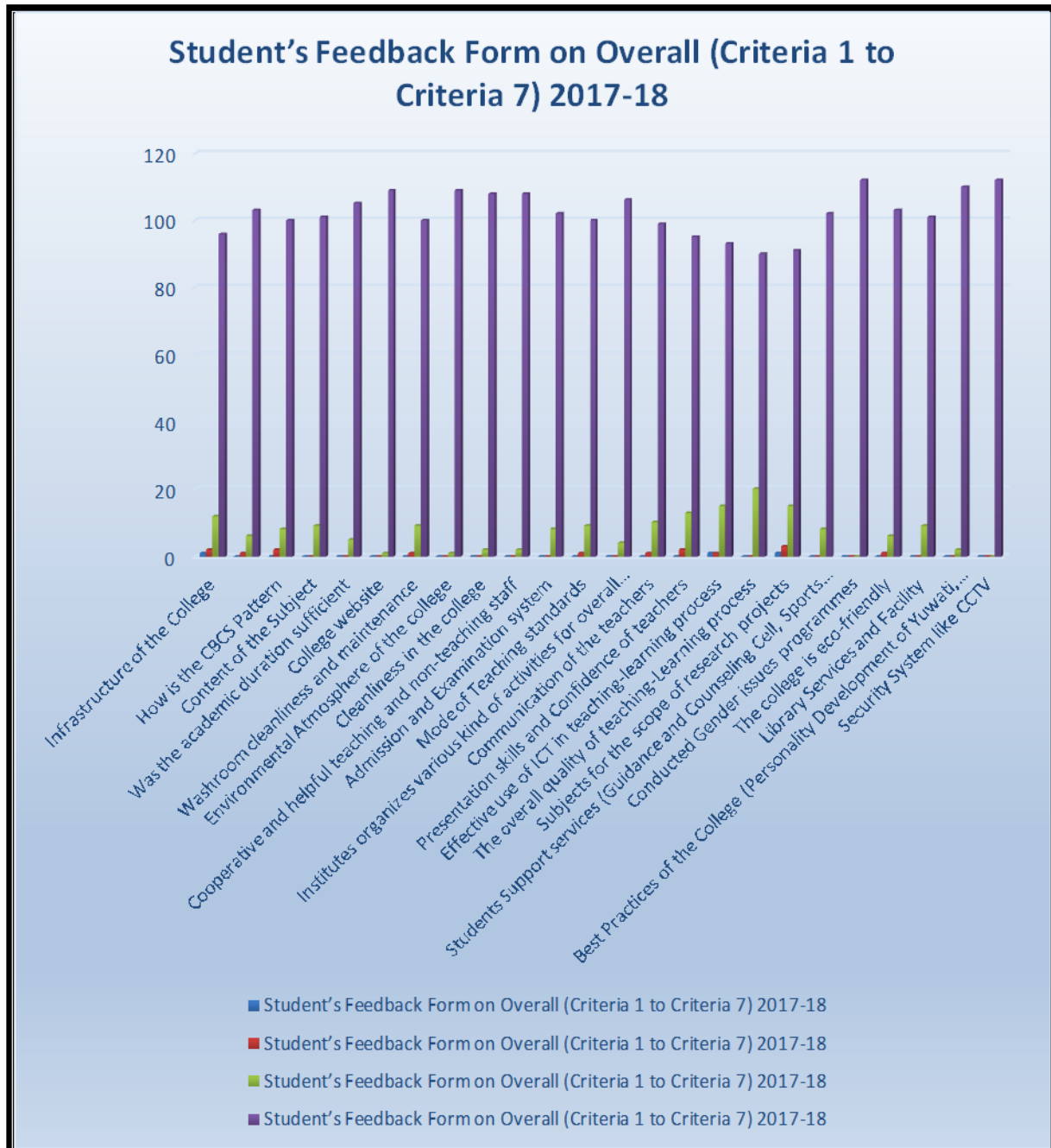
Graphical Representation 2016-17

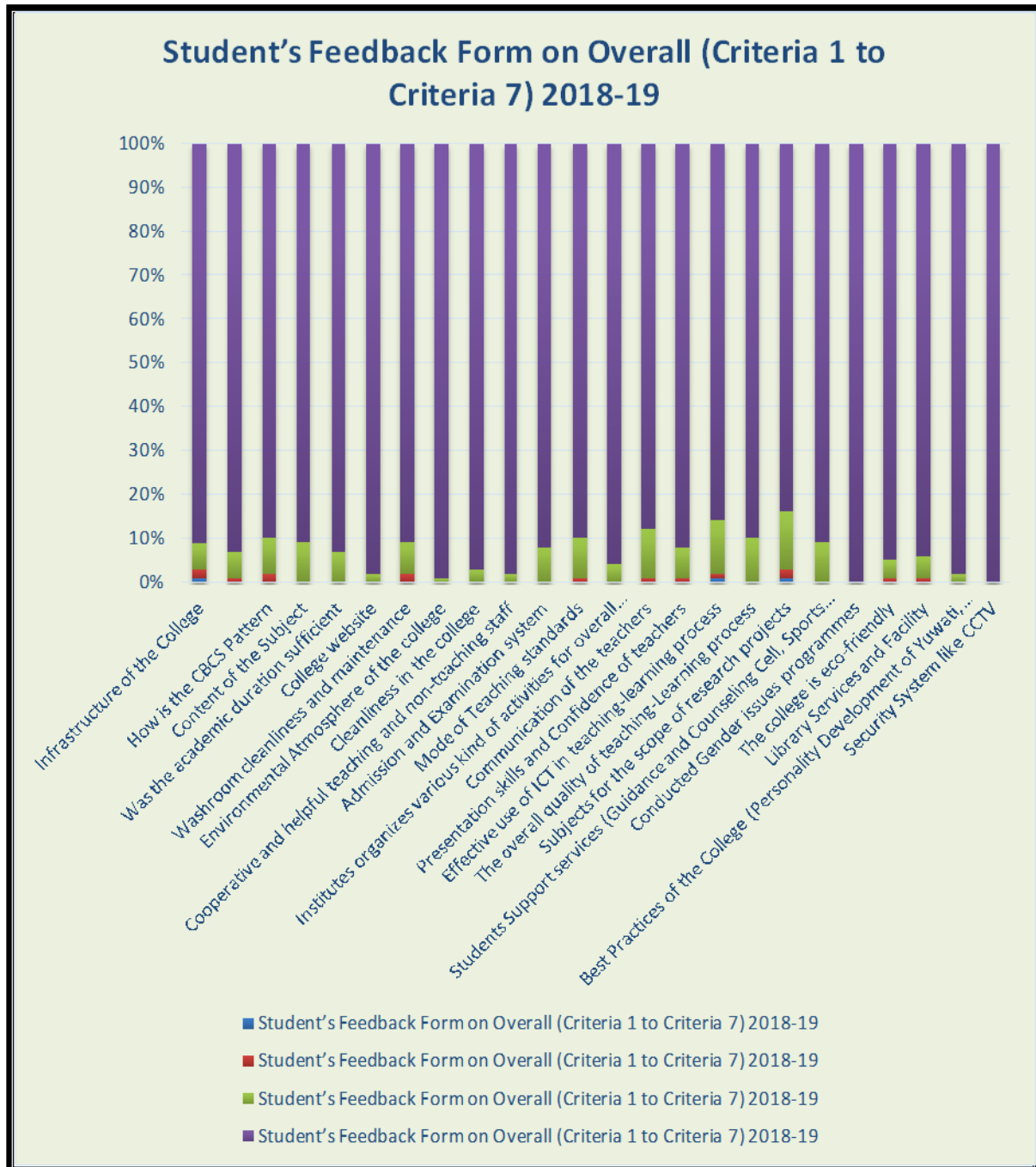
Graphical Representation 2017-18

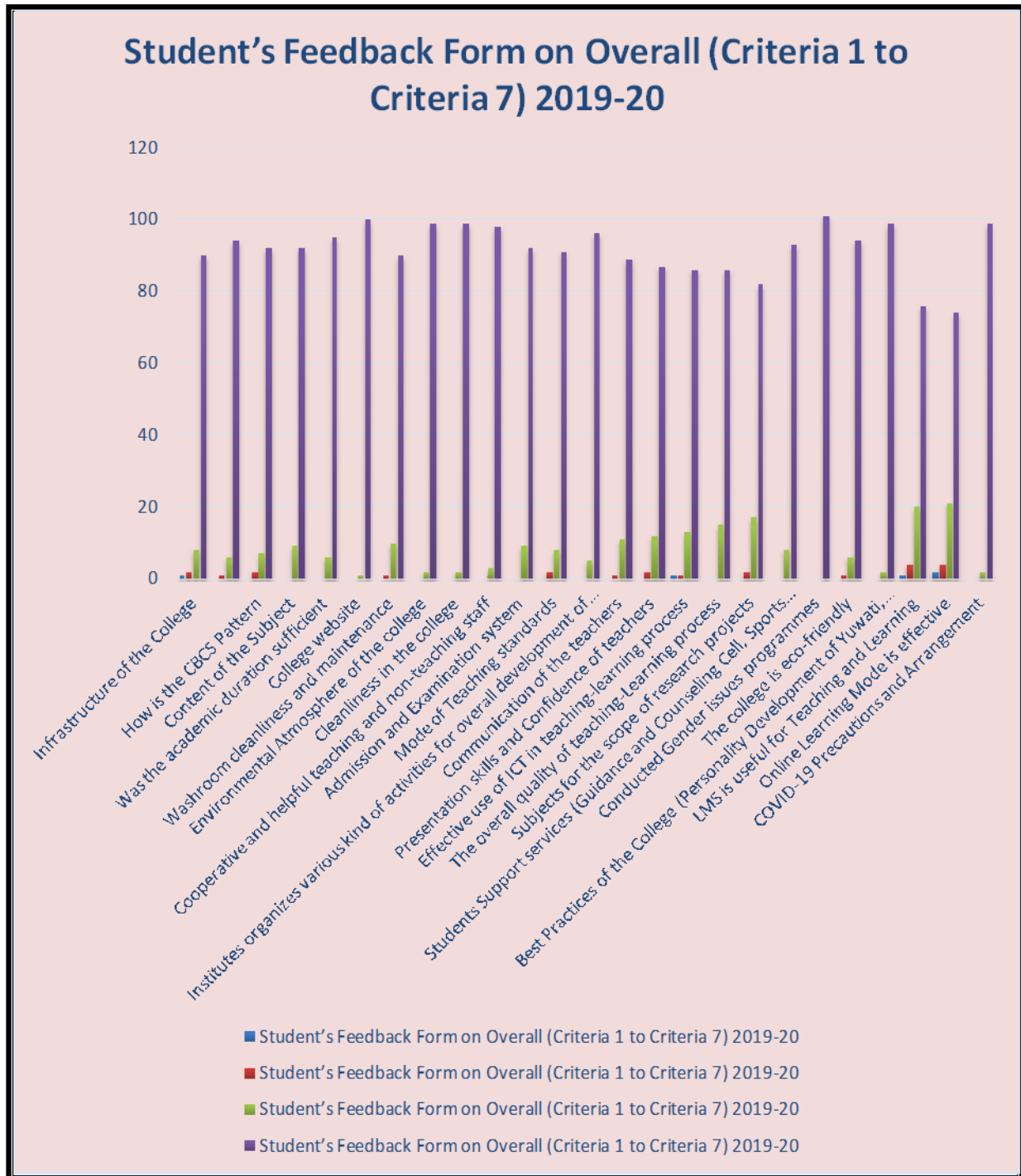
Graphical Representation 2018-19

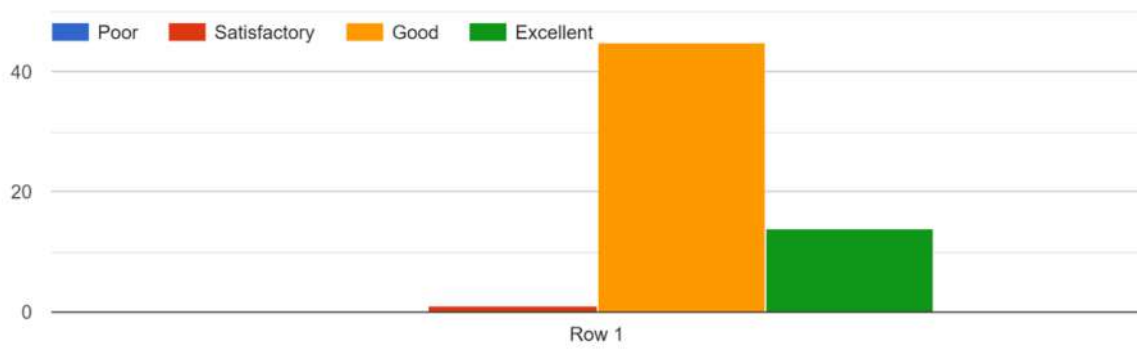
