

So, on the internet, you can learn how to keep yourself safe without falling prey to any temptation. In spite of all these things, if a student or a woman is a victim of cyber crime without knowing it, then it is important for her to know her own authority. And in such cases, it is important to have all the evidence related to cyber crime.

She further said that Women should have the courage to say no to any threat. Only then we and family can we keep ourselves safe. He highlighted the nature of the crime in cyber crime and the punishment to be meted out by the court and said that if a child under the age of 18 commits a crime; his parents have to compensate his parents.


