Jagannath Kadwadas Shah Adarsh College was established in 1995 to cater to the higher educational needs of the rural and tribal people of hilly area. Empower the rural and tribal students through value based and life oriented quality education is the mission of the college. N.J.S.P Mandal's Jagannath Kadwadas Shah Adarsh College has 2f and 12(B).Status of UGC and permanent affiliation with Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. The College has 3.21 acres of existing campus and five acres of new campus for future development. The College offers B.A. degree in special subjects English, Marathi, Hindi, Political Science, Sociology and Geography, Economics, History, and Defence Studies are offered as general subjects. The college also offers certificate courses and Add-on courses.

The college is reaccredited by NAAC with CGPA of 1.75 on four point scale at 'C' Grade in Second cycle. The college has organized university level, state level, national level and international seminars, conferences, workshops and webinars. There is a good work culture in our college. Our College always organizes university, state, national workshops, conferences, seminars. Since 2006 our college organized 18 University Level, 03 State Level and 03 National Level Seminars, Conference and Workshop. The new best activity of Developing Research Culture Initiatives has been started from 2016 to till this day. It is resulted in the completion of research for Ph.D. and publication of research papers. by day. The girls are not coming into the main stream of education in hilly area. Women of hilly area face a number of health, livelihood and financial issues. That is why the activities are organized every year for girls like university level workshop on Personality Development of Yuwati, Swayamsiddha Shibir, organized rally on Beti Bachhav Beti Padhav, Rangoli competition on Save Girls Child, Presentation platform, participation in Essay, Debate, Elocution competition and Sport opportunities.

Our college teachers and students have participated in 'Avishkar' organized Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon. Rukmini-Narayan Bedse Research Prize Sponsored by Professor P.N.Patil (USA) and one prize is a research prize which is given to a senior student who publishes research paper in reputed journals.

Our college conducted Swachha Bharat Abhiyan in college campus as well as nearby villages. Hence, the Certificate provided by Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India

During COVID-19 pandemic our college organized 29 webinars in online mode.
